



Dear Parents/Carers,

Summer Weather

I hope you are enjoying the sunshine!

As I am sure you will agree, it is important that the children are aware of how to stay safe during the warmer weather. Please can I ask we work together to help your child do this in the following ways:



- Children must have all-day **sun cream** applied **before school**. Sun cream brought into school must be clearly labelled with the child's name and class. **Staff will not be able to apply sun cream for children**, children will need to apply this themselves and it must not be shared with others for allergy reasons.
- Please can you ensure children bring a **sun hat/cap** and water bottle to school everyday.

As a school we will:



- Ensure PE or physical activity only takes place if an adult feels it is safe to do so and only for a short period of time, making use of indoor, ventilated spaces such as the school hall.
- Encourage children to take their jumpers or cardigans off when the weather is warm.
- Ensure lunchtime and break times are limited to minimum time outside and it may be that adults decide that it is better to remain in ventilated classroom spaces.
- Ensure staff encourage children to drink regularly throughout the day.
- Ensure the building is ventilated as much as possible; all windows and internal doors will be open and window coverings will be used where necessary.
