The winning team will enjoy special DREAM Time as a reward, where they will have the chance to mix with children from across the school, all working together to make their team a success.

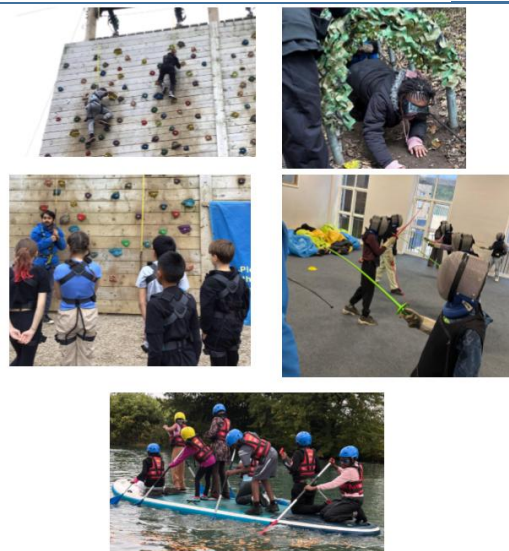
