Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you of a serious incident that took place this morning on Dewsbury Road involving a car. We are aware many of you may have witnessed this or have now seen social media posts relating to the incident.

After speaking with police, we have been advised that there are no injuries or fatalities linked to this incident and that the driver of the car left the scene.

Emergency services attended the scene promptly, and the situation was managed quickly and professionally. We understand that incidents of this nature can be concerning, particularly when they occur close to the school community. Please be assured that the safety and wellbeing of our pupils remain our highest priority.

All children have been reassured and spoken to by leaders first thing this morning to clarify that nobody was hurt. We are aware that pupils are likely to talk about this over the course of the day so all staff are available throughout the day to provide reassurance and support to any child who may feel unsettled or upset.

For the families and adults who witnessed this and experienced significant distress our pastoral team within school are continuing to support them. If you yourself require any support, have any information or would like signposting to any wider professionals please do not hesitate to come into school and speak with us. We understand the impact this will have on our community.

We will continue to liaise with the relevant authorities and will share any further information if appropriate. In the meantime, if you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to contact the school office.
