We celebrated World Book Day on Thursday. The children had a wonderful day dressing up and sharing their books in the big book swap. Thank you for all your support and generosity. Here are some of our memories of the day.



Behaviour Focus – World Book Day

For World Book Day, we are exploring how we can self-regulate our feelings. Sometimes our emotions can feel very big – like anger – and our brains might feel like they are “flipping their lid.” This is normal! As a school, we are focusing on learning safe ways to manage our emotions. The book helps us see that it’s okay to feel angry, but not okay to hurt ourselves, others, or things. We are practicing tools to calm down, think, and make safe choices so we can keep learning and having fun together

Thrive at Home

For World Book Day, you can help your child **manage big feelings with a story**. Read a favourite book together and pause when a character feels angry or upset. Ask your child how the character feels and how their own body feels. Practice calming tools like **balloon breaths, counting to ten, or hugging a soft toy**. This helps children **flip their lid safely** and learn to manage emotions just like the characters in the story.
