Information for the new academic year

Uniform

Due to the decrease in the sports premium that we receive as a School, we have had to make the difficult decision to stop giving a new PE kit to all year groups. Children starting school in Reception will continue to be given free PE kit.

We ask for all children to wear the following on the day of their PE lesson.

- a white t-shirt- **the t- shirt does not need to have the school logo on**
- black jogging bottoms
- suitable trainers or pumps (for indoor PE)

In order to support families, we will have a 'swap shop' that families can access during parent consultations. The 'swap shop' will be available each day in the school hall giving families the opportunity to pick up good quality pre-loved school uniforms and PE kits free of charge. If you have any school uniform or PE kit that your child has outgrown and is still in good condition, we would be very grateful for your donations. If you would like to donate any items before the parent consultation evenings, please drop these off at the school office. Alternatively, you can bring your donations with you to parent consultations.

School meal prices for 2026/2027

The cost of a school meal will increase from 1st September to £3.05 per day. This is for any child who will be taking a paid meal in Nursery and Year groups 3 to 6.

Milk prices for 2026/2027

There will be no price increase for school milk.

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Please can I take this opportunity to remind you that the last day of this academic year is **Friday 17th July**, finishing at 3.15pm. All children in Years 1- 6 are expected to return on **Thursday 3rd September 2026**.

For pupils in Reception and Nursery, all children have been given an individual starting date. Please ensure you link with the Office team if you are unsure of the specific arrangements for your child(ren).
