As you are aware, Reading at Hunslet Moor Primary is a priority for all. We understand how important it is for your children to leave us at the end of Year 6 being fluent, confident and life-long readers.

With the implementation of the Read, Write Inc phonics and reading programme in the Autumn Term, we are already recording a huge improvement in the children's ability to read. For our children who are not accessing Read, Write Inc, we have invested in high-quality reading books which have improved the classroom libraries and learning environments across the school.

Reading for Pleasure is vital for deepening a child's love of reading and that is why we are committed to providing all of our children with high quality books to read for pleasure at home. **You will notice that your child comes home with a book that matches their reading ability and another book that they may need support from you to read.** Reading with an adult at home improves many aspects of a child's development: they sleep better, their vocabulary increases and their fluency improves.

Some of the books that will be coming home with your child soon are brand new. We are asking that your child looks after these books at home and brings them back to school in their book bags each day. Any lost or damaged books will incur a £5 charge, payable on parentpay.
