School Dinners will cost £12 per week from September 2022

The Government provides funding for schools to offer free school meals to pupils in Reception, Year 1, and Year 2. This stops when a child moves into Year 3.

Therefore, when your child moves into Year 3 in September you will have to pay £12 per week (£2.40 per meal) if you want them to continue having school meals.

Your child may be entitled to free school meals if you claim certain benefits. We have a list of children entitled to these free meals from Leeds City Council and you are welcome to call the school office to check if your child is on this list. If you think your child may qualify then you should make a claim direct to Leeds City Council.

Paying for school dinners

We do not accept cash in school.

To pay for your child's school meals you will need to create an account on the School Money website. We will send you a link to this website at the beginning of September. You will be able to create your account from this link. You may have used this website already to pay for school trips. Alternatively, you can call at the school office to obtain a paper barcode which you can scan at a PayPoint machine to make payment by cash or debit card.

Packed lunches

You are welcome to provide your child with a packed lunch in Year 3 instead of a school meal. We ask that this is made with healthy food and snacks. Please do not send your child with nuts or use chocolate spreads like Nutella. If you have any questions, please call the school office on 0113 271 7257.
