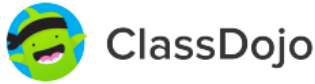

At Hunslet Moor, we place an extremely high value on the importance of reading. Our aim is to instil a love of reading and story-telling in our pupils. We have invested heavily in our class and school libraries and have a wonderful range of books for the children to enjoy. As a staff we have been considering a more efficient way to keep track of children's reading; we wanted to find an easy and engaging way to record the reading the children do at home. As such, we have been looking for an online reading record and after some research, we have decided to trial logging our reading on Class Dojo in Year 2, 5 and 6.

The benefits of using Class Dojo to record reading:

- Instant whole class view by teachers of reading records and books
- Quick and easy to use
- Record reading on any device connected to the internet
- No loss of paper records
- Digital rewards for children reading at home
- Simple login to record reading
- Quick and easy communication with school (tricky words/general comments) to support home reading

### Getting Started

The children will simply add a reading entry to their portfolio by clicking 'create new' and then the journal icon here ----->  
 Your child may want to write the title of the book they're reading and the page number they got up to. They might add a comment about how they are enjoying the book. Their class teacher will respond to the entries and reward reading at home with class dojos.
