
World Mental Health Day is about raising awareness of mental health and driving positive change for everyone's mental health.

At Hunslet Moor Primary School we want to ensure that all children attend school every day on time at 8.45am



96% - 100% - Excellent Attendance Good attendance gives you the best chance to succeed

90% - 95% - Attendance causing concern. Poor attendance gives you less chance to achieve their potential. Attendance Provision Plan to be put in place.

Below 90% - Attendance is being monitored. Very poor attendance has a serious impact on your child's learning. Your child may struggle to achieve their targets and exam results. Possible FINE or PROSECUTION.
