Learning in Nursery

This term's topic will be All about me. We have planned lots of exciting activities to extend and develop your child's learning in all areas of the curriculum. You can help by as always chatting to your children and supporting the development of their communication skills. Reading, daily if possible, with your child and discussing as many stories as you can. Learning nursery rhymes is important at this age so please do sing them with your child. We will also be focusing on number 1-5. Can you encourage your child to count objects up to 5. This could be when setting up the table "get me 5 forks...1,2,3,4,5".

What your child needs to bring to nursery

- Please can you ensure that you bring a bag with spare clothes in every day in case your child needs changing.
- If your child is not yet toilet trained do make us aware and send your child to nursery in pull up **not** nappies so we can support them going to the toilet independently. You will also need to provide spare pull-ups and wipes for if your child needs to be changed. We expect all pupils to be toilet trained as soon as possible.
- Children need to have suitable clothes in order to play outside. Keep in mind that the children will be playing outside every day and that the weather could change. We advise bringing a waterproof coat every day and wearing suitable shoes.



Every parent is expected to access their child's online learning journal. This is done through a wonderful website call 'Tapestry'. We upload weekly observations of your child's learning, and it is a great way to see how they are progressing through Nursery and beyond. What's great is that you can also add things to show us what they are learning at home.

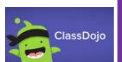
