



Autumn - Year 1



Topic - Life in Leeds

This term, Year 1 will be learning all about Life in Leeds, including what it is like where we live. They will learn about features of the local areas, maps of the area and describing where they live and what they can see in the surrounding area.

Reading

Reading is a priority at Hunslet Moor and we encourage children to read as regularly as possible.

We will be sending reading books home next week. Please try to listen to your child read as much as possible and encourage your child to read every evening for at least 10 minutes.

Always write a comment in their reading journal to show their teacher they have read at home.

If you have any school reading books at home please can these be returned to your child's class teacher as soon as possible. Thank you!

Maths

We will be focusing on Place Value within 10 and reinforcing children's understanding of number throughout the autumn term. The children will then move on to looking at addition and subtraction within 10 and will learn how to use practical apparatus to support them with their calculations. Towards the end of the term children will then revisit place value but this time within 20. Children will be taught how to find one more and one less than a given number, how to group objects and about how to partition a 2 digit number.

Homework

Please support your child by practising their phonic sounds and homework which will be sent out each week.

PE

In Year 1 this term, we will be teaching the children ball skills such as throwing and catching and gymnastics

Please wear the school PE kit you were provided with last year into school on the correct PE day. Your child's PE day is **on a Wednesday and Thursday.**

Science

This half term, we will be learning about plants and animals and where we live. They will learn about various plants, trees and identify groups of animals and what they eat.

PSHE

PSHE is a core part of our school ethos. During the Autumn term, we will be exploring the topics of Families and caring friendships.

Thank You for supporting school with the changes to the timings of the day. We begin school at 8.45am and finish school at 3.15pm. It is important you continue to send your child to school every day and arrive on time so that we are all ready to begin the days learning.
