Topic - Up, up and away!

This term, Year 2 will be learning about the first aeroplane flight. They will be taking part in a history topic, learning about who George Caley Scarborough is and how the first man learnt to fly.

Reading

Reading is a priority at Hunslet Moor and we encourage children to read as regularly as possible.

We will be sending reading books home next week. Please try to listen to your child read as much as possible and encourage your child to read every evening for at least 10 minutes.

Year 2 will be using reading records to check home reading. Please can you make sure these are filled out and returned to school daily.

If you have any school reading books at home please can these be returned to your child's class teacher as soon as possible. Thank you!

Maths

We will be focusing on Place Value and reinforcing children's understanding of number throughout the autumn term. The children will then move on to looking at addition and subtraction, building on their knowledge from last year. Children will move away from the concept of using practical resources and will begin to learn methods for mental arithmetic as well as more complex written methods. Towards the end of the term children will be taught the topic of Money. A very useful skill! Children will learn to recognise, add and work out change.

Homework

Please support your child by practising their spellings and homework which will be sent out each week.

In Year 2 this half term, we will be teaching the children skills such as running, jumping and throwing.
