English

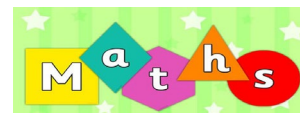
We will continue to focus on Listening and attention, understanding and speaking objectives aimed at your child's level.

Apply for a primary school

If your child was born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020 they should start primary school in September 2024. You will need to make an application for a place at a primary school.

How to apply

You can apply online. Go to <https://www.leeds.gov.uk/schools-and-education/school-admissions/apply-for-a-primary-school>

You can apply from 1st November 2023. The deadline to apply is 15th January 2024.

When you'll find out

You will be offered a primary school place on 16th April 2024. If you applied on line you will receive an email. If you applied in any other way, you will receive an offer letter to your registered home address a few days after the 16th April.
