School Uniform

All children need to come to school in their full school uniform each day. As the weather is getting colder please also send your child with a warm coat and suitable footwear. **Please can all items be labelled with your child's name.** This also applies to hats/scarves/gloves. If your child misplaces an item of clothing it is much easier to locate if it is named. If you have any problems with acquiring uniform for your child please talk to a member of staff.

Class Dojo

A huge thankyou to everyone who has signed up to Class Dojo. We use Dojo to share key messages regularly so please ensure that you check it often. You can also use Dojo to message your class teacher about any problems as we know it can get very busy on the doors! If you have any issues with accessing Dojo or if you need a new log in, please talk to a member of staff and we can sort this for you.

Reading

Reading continues to be a priority. We ask that you read with your child at least 3x a week at home and write a short comment in their reading record. All children have a reading for pleasure book for you to share together and a blending book for the children to practice their reading independently. We also ask that you practice the weekly learnt sounds in phonics with your child by scanning the QR codes sent home each week.

Reception—Celebrations

Our topic this half term is celebrations. First we will be looking at birthdays using the story 'Kipper's Birthday'. We will look at how to write a birthday card, features of invitations and read and write instructions about how to make a cake. We will also be making cakes just like Kipper! Later on in the term we will be writing Christmas lists and cards and looking at the Christmas story. We will also be looking at different events people celebrate such as Diwali and Hannukah and learning that not everybody chooses to celebrate events in the same way.
