## Geography

Extreme Earth: Japan

This term, Year 6 will be starting their geography topic, Extreme Earth: Japan. We will be answering the question: 'What is it like to live in a seismic country?'

Our aims will be to use a world map to locate Japan, as well as the surrounding seas and oceans; understand the causes of earthquakes, tsunamis and volcanoes and the impact these have on Japan and to explore the physical geography of Japan, comparing it to the UK.

Reading

Reading is a priority at Hunslet Moor and we encourage children to read as regularly as possible as this supports them with the wider curriculum.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on units of measure and ratio, whilst continuing to reinforce children's understanding of number through weekly arithmetic tests. We will be exploring both metric and imperial measures and learning to convert between different units of measure, as well as exploring the relationship between ratio and fractions, using scale factors and solving a wide range of reasoning questions.

It is important that children know their times tables up to 12x12, along with corresponding division facts.
