Geography

Extreme Earth: Japan

This term, Year 6 will be continuing their geography topic, Extreme Earth: Japan. We will be answering the question: 'What is it like to live in a seismic country?'

Our aims will be to use a world map to locate Japan, as well as the surrounding seas and oceans; understand the causes of earthquakes, tsunamis and volcanoes and the impact these have on Japan and to explore the physical geography of Japan, comparing it to the UK.

Reading

Reading is a priority at Hunslet Moor and we encourage children to read as regularly as possible as this supports them with the wider curriculum.

Please try to listen to your child read as often as possible and encourage your child to read every evening for at least 15 minutes.

If you have any books that belong to school, please support us by bringing them in.

Don't forget that on 7th March we will be celebrating World Book Day. Please come dressed up as a word. Please also bring an pre-loved book to exchange on the day in Hunslet Moor's BIG BOOK SWAP!

Maths

This term we will be focusing on algebra, ratio and proportion. We will be learning to form expressions and answer a range of 1 and 2 step equations, as well as understanding how to use a given ratio to solve a range of problems. In addition to this, we will be continuing to reinforce the children's understanding of number through weekly arithmetic tests as well as introducing afternoon maths booster sessions.
